Summary

Most Guests gamble responsibly, but some do not. Those with an uncontrollable urge to gamble need support. Casinos have responsible gambling programs and materials in place, but you need to connect them with problem gamblers. Your frontline staff is in an ideal position to make that connection, provided they can recognize statements that signal a problem.

Their responsibility is not to judge Guests. Instead, they will learn how to refer trained staff to struggling Guests or take a proactive approach for Guests who request help. Learners will recognize factors that contribute to problem gambling, such as excess alcohol consumption and underage gambling. The course keeps learners engaged through interactive elements such as trigger-based actions and assessments.

- Respond to problem gamblers who request help.
